


Erotic content level: High with some drama. But funny.


Suitable for people with great sense of humor, freedom lovers and those who has taken advantage of their broken hearts.


The protagonist of **Heels for Kicks** is a heroine who allows us to experience the process of infidelity step by step, in her colorful heels.
